

in several parcels between 1977 and 1991. The property offers some rough trails, which WPC stewardship staff are working to improve, and includes some nice oak and northern hardwoods forest as well as some forest which has been heavily impacted by invasive understory shrubs like multiflora rose. Parking for Tom's **Run Nature Reserve is located** along Tom's Run Rd, just east of I-79 and northwest of Emsworth in Allegheny County.
